

2019-2022 Freightliner/Mercedes-Benz Sprinter 2500-4500 3.0L V6 Diesel w/-w/o A/C, w/o Mercedes-Benz N62 or N63 Options

> Requires 6-Groove Pulley For use w/ J180 Style Alternator 375% Overdrive Ratio w/ 2" Diameter Pulley

Wrenches are available and suggested for removal and retorquing the harmonic balancer bolts. PART# VFL23WR-1 & VFL23WR-2.

These are sold separately.

INSTALLATION NOTES

- 1. The buyer is responsible for providing trained and experienced installation decision making with technical know-how to apply professional judgment that specifically applies to each individual installation.
- 2. Be sure to read and understand all available information including but not limited to instructions, warnings, sale terms, and warranties for the vehicle and all system components prior to attempting installation.
- 3. Remove harmonic balancer bolt using wrench (PART# VFL23WR-1 (sold separately)).
- 4. Install pulley adaptor (1) using bolt (3), OEM spacer, and set screws (4). Torque harmonic balancer bolt to 280 ft/lbs. using wrench (PART# VFL23WR-2 (sold separately)). Cross-torque set screws to the following specs (a mild-grade of Loctite is advisable to use):
 - a. 10 in/lbs.
 - b. 30 in/lbs.
 - c. 60 in/lbs.
 - d. 90 in/lbs.
 - e. 120 in/lbs.

Install drive pulley (2) with bolts (5) to pulley adaptor (1).

- 5. Install main bracket (6) with bolts (8) at location [A]. Check for gaps at location [B]. Remove bracket (6) and install appropriate shims (20-22) at location [B] if necessary. Remove the two lower bolts from the OEM alternator. Reinstall main bracket (6) with bolts (9) and selected shims (20-22) (if used) at location [B]. Then, install brace (7) onto main bracket (6) using bolts (8) (do not tighten). Install the two OEM lower alternator bolts back into alternator through the brace (7). Torque bolts (8-9) and two OEM lower alternator bolts to 20 ft/lbs.
- 6. Install FEAD brace (10) to mounting bracket (6) using bolts (11), and to the engine at location [C] using bolt (12) and spacer (13).
- 7. Install smooth idler assembly (16-19) onto FEAD brace (10).
- 8. Install belt tensioner (14) using bolt (15) onto FEAD brace (10).
- 9. Install auxiliary alternator using bolts (23-28).
- 10. Install new drive belt (29). Fan shroud may need to be trimmed for clearance with the drive belt and tensioner.


<u>WARNING:</u> Before starting the engine. Check to make certain no wires, hoses, etc. that may have been disturbed during installation do not come in contact with any hot or moving parts. Run the engine and check for proper belt tracking, adjust if necessary. It is the installer's responsibility to make sure that all components are in proper position and alignment.




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Mounting Locations
