Wrenches are Available and Suggested for Removal and Re-torquing Harmonic Balancer Bolt, Part# VFL23WR-1 &VFL23WR-2. These Are Sold Separately.

INSTALLATION NOTES

- 1. The buyer is responsible for providing trained and experienced installation decision making with technical know-how to apply professional judgment that specifically applies to each individual installation.
- 2. Be sure to read and understand all available information including but not limited to instructions, warnings, sale terms, and warranties for the vehicle and all system components prior to attempting installation.
- 3. Remove air cleaner assembly. Remove the fan and fan shroud. Remove harmonic balancer bolt using wrench (pn. VFLWR-1 sold separately)(bolt has right hand threads).
- 4. Install pulley adapter(1) using bolt(3), O.E.M. spacer, and set screws(4). Install pulley (2) onto adapter (1) using bolts (5). Torque harmonic balancer bolt to 280 ft/lbs using wrench (pn. VFLWR-2 sold separately). Cross-torque set screws at 10 in/lbs, 30 in/lbs, 60 in/lbs, 90 in/lbs, 120 in/lbs. Mild-grade of Loctite is advisable to use. Install studs (9) with red lock-tight and torque to 5 ft.lbs.. Install main bracket (6) with nuts (16) at locations "A" and "B". Check for gap at locations "C" and "D" with feelers gauge. Remove bracket (6) and install appropriate shims (22,23) on studs at locations "C" and "D". Reinstall main bracket (6) using nuts (16) and brace (24). Install front brace (7)using bolts (11,12), lockwasher(10), and spacer(8). Install belt tensioner(13) using bolt(14).
- 5. Install A.C. compressor using slide bushings(20), bolts(17,18), and nuts(19). Install new drive belt(15). Install fan spacer(21), fan, and fan shroud. Fan shroud will need to be trimmed for clearance with the drive belt and tensioner. Run the engine and check for proper belt alignment, tracking, and clearances.

NOTE: Make certain any hoses or wires that were disturbed during installation do not come in contact with any hot or moving parts.

Disclaimer: (1.) Due to the custom nature and variation of all add-on systems of this type, no complete system kits are offered by the manufacturer, and any group of parts marketed as a kit is limited to only the individually defined parts in that specific kit. Any additional items required, beyond those included in the kit, are to be provided at the expense of the buyer. (4.) The buyer is responsible for the development and communication of their whole system installation procedures, safety precautions, application, and use of the engine accessory mounting kit in their system, including efforts to maintain vehicle control and prevent pinch, wear, impact, and/ or burn exposure on all hoses, wires, and other parts. (5.) The buyer is responsible for providing trained and experienced installation decision making with technical know-how to apply professional judgment that specifically applies to each individual installation. The buyers chosen installers must be qualified and experienced technicians that are familiar with the vehicle and accessory being mounted as well as the buyer's whole system design and installation procedures associated with the kit. (6.) The buyer is responsible for determining and achieving compliance to all regulatory issues that apply to the use of all products. (7.) 
